Across all industries, there is a **substantial Talent Shortage in Ireland with 81%** of employers having difficulty finding the right talent. This is a dramatic increase from 2014, where the Talent Shortage was only at 11% in Ireland. The snapshot below reveals the current **Talent Shortage across each vertical within the Irish Market.**

Although there is an evidently large Talent Shortage within the Irish Market for 2024, there is still a positive Net Employment Outlook percentage, i.e. how many Employers plan to hire, with a 25% NEO for Q3 2024, an increase of 4% since Q1 2024. Companies are still eager to hire, but finding difficulty sourcing the right talent. It is Manpower Ireland's goal to bridge this gap, and match the highest quality candidates with our clients continuously.

Marketing Industry Overview

The hiring demand for Marketing Professionals remains high in Ireland, with around only 16% of this talent pool changing jobs within the last year, leaving 84% passive. Marketing professionals tend to stay approximately 1.2 years with their current employers, which is a relatively high turnover of staff. The Marketing industry holds a diverse talent pool with a gender split of 61% female, and 39% male.

The **Top 5 Skills** trending within this industry include:

- Social Media Marketing
- Search Engine Optimization (SEO)
- Email Marketing
- Marketing Research

Supply Chain & Logistics Industry Overview

There is a large hiring demand for Supply Chain & Logistics Professionals in Ireland. Job switching behaviour is relatively low within the Logistics & Supply chain sector with only 13% of this talent pool changing jobs within the last year. Professionals within the Logistics & Supply Chain industry tend to stay 1.5 years with their current employers, which reveals the ideal time to approach these professionals.

There is a lack of gender diversity within the Logistics & Supply Chain industry with a **gender split of 29% female, and 71% male.** The **Top 5 Skills** trending within this industry include, Operations Management, Aviation, Logistics Management, Supply Chain Management, and Airlines.

Accounting & Finance Industry Overview

The hiring demand for Engineering professionals remains high in Ireland. Only 12% of Accounting & Finance Professionals have switched jobs within the last year in Ireland. There appears to be a large portion of the market hesitant to change roles. Accounting & Finance professionals tend to stay with their employers for approximately 1.6 years, which is a relatively short time-frame.

There is **a healthy, diverse gender split** within the Accounting and Finance sector with a gender breakdown of **46% Female, and 54% Male,** nearly a 50/50 split. The **Top 5 Skills** within this industry include, Finance, Banking, Financial Services, Risk Management, and Financial Analysis.

A substantial **90% of employers** within the Financial Industry are **experiencing difficulty hiring** in Ireland.

Engineering Industry Overview

The hiring demand within the Engineering sector remains high in Ireland. Only 13% of this talent pool has switched jobs within the last year, indicating that there is some resistance to change jobs. 1.7 years is the median tenure for Engineering professionals, which is slightly below the overall average median tenure 2 years, that professionals across all sectors tend to stay with current employers.

There is quite a lack of diversity within the Engineering sector with a gender split of 80% Male, and 20% Female. The Top Skills trending within this industry include, Construction Management, Civil Engineering, Construction Engineering, and, CAD Tools. 87% of Employers are struggling to find the right talent within the Engineering space.

Life Sciences Industry Overview

The Life Sciences sector reports a Net Employment Outlook of 32% (employers expecting to hire) for Q2 2024, solidifying that this industry remains the keenest to hire across Ireland. There was a NEO of 40% for Life Science Employers in Q1 2024, so although there is a slight decrease, it is still considered a very positive hiring outlook. Professionals within the Life Sciences sector tend to stay approximately 1.7 years with their current employers, which is slightly below the average time spent with employers across all industries (2 years).

There is a diverse talent pool within the Life Sciences Sector with a gender split of 56% Male, and 44% Female. The Top Skills trending within this industry include, Manufacturing, Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP), Pharmaceuticals, Engineering, and Quality Assurance. Although the NEO for the Life Sciences sector is increasingly positive, there is still a substantial talent shortage within the industry, with 84% of Life Science Employers struggling to find the talent they need.

With only 12% of this talent pool switching jobs in the last year, it is clear to see that there is a high percentage of professionals within this sector that are hesitant to leave their roles. IT & Tech Industry Overview

The hiring demand for IT & Tech Professionals remains high in Ireland. Job switching behaviour is relatively low within the IT industry with only 11% of this talent pool changing jobs within the last year. Professionals within the IT industry tend to stay 1.8 years with their current employers, signifying a relatively low brand loyalty amongst professionals within this sector.

There is a slight lack of diversity within the Tech industry with a **gender split of 37% female**, **and 63% male**, **but this is an improvement over the last few years**. The **Top 5 Skills** trending within this industry include, Information Technology, Software Development, SQL, Consumer Services, and Operations.

Across all industries, there is a a significant Talent Shortage (81%) in Ireland. The IT & Tech sector has one of the largest Talent Shortages across all verticals, with **90% of employers** within the IT & Tech Industry **experiencing difficulty hiring in Ireland.**

The hiring demand for Professionals within the Construction sector remains high in Ireland.
